





## STEP 1

Note The longer end of the (A) Base/Frame goes towards the front. First place (A) base/Frame in any chair. Note: Using a rocking chair will give the best effect.

(Chair is not included)




## STEP 2

Now, plug in the UL Power Adapter into the input receiving jack "DC 6V" on the Function Control Box.


Note: Do not plug UL Power Adapter into power outlet until item assembly is completed.

Optional: If you choose to use (B) Step Here Try-Me Activation Pad, plug the connector into the input receiving jack marked "TRY ME" on the Function Control Box and set the Step Here pad in front of the character when ready to display.




### STEP 3

Place the (C) Head Shoulder Frame onto the support pole of the (A) Base/Frame as shown and secure by aligning the quick-connect push button into the pre-drilled hole.




### STEP 4

Lower the (D) Costume over the (C) Head and (A) Base/Frame and pull the dress forward between the chair and the (A) Base/Frame so the mechanism is inside the costume.




### STEP 5

Place (E) Baby Support Cradle by sliding the Forked-Hook Into the front of the (A) Base/Frames slot housing. Note: there is a pre cut hole for this in the front of the Costume.



### STEP 6

Slide the (F) Right Arm up through the right sleeve and slide the forked-hook into the Right "shoulder" slot on the (C) Head Shoulder Frame. Slide the (G) Left Arm up through the left sleeve and slide the forked-hook into the left "shoulder" slot on the (C) Head Shoulder Frame.



#### STEP 8

Slide the (H) Right Leg up through the bottom of the costume and slide the forked-hook into right slot on the (A) Base/Frame. Slide the (I) Left Leg up through the bottom of the costume and slide the forked-hook into left slot on the (A) Base/Frame. Pull (D) Costume down over the legs.



#### STEP 7

Wrap (J) Baby in (K) blanket and place with the head to the left on the (E) Baby Support Cradle.



#### STEP 8

Place (L) Shawl over her shoulders to complete the look.



#### OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Plug the UL Power Adapter into a standard power outlet and adjust the settings on the Function Control Box to your liking.
2. Moldy Mommy has 3 operation settings which can be found on the main Function Control Box on the (A) Base/Frame:
  - Continuous rocking with sounds.
  - Continuous rocking with sensor pad-activated sounds.
  - Sensor pad-activated rocking and sounds.
3. The Function Control Box also includes a Volume control knob, which allows you to adjust the volume to be as loud or as quiet as needed. Be sure to test the item before finalizing your display so you can set the volume to your liking.
